

A Quarter Charmed – Square Version

32" x 32"

Fabric Supplies:

40 – 5" Charm Squares

3/8 yard inner and outer border

3/8 yard middle border

1/3 yard binding

1 yard backing

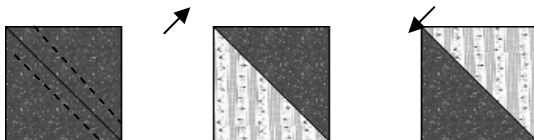
Cutting:

From the inner and out border, cut 8 – 1 1/2" strips.

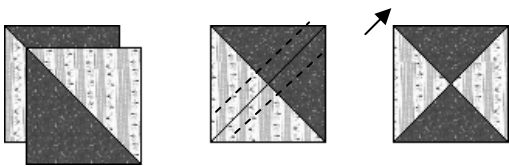
From the middle border, cut 4 – 4" strips.

From the binding fabric, cut 4 – 2 1/4" strips

1. Pair your 40 charm squares together to make 20 pairs.
2. On the back of one charm square from a pair, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Place the drawn square right sides together with its pair. Sew a 1/4" on each side of the line. Cut exactly on the line and iron towards the darker fabric.

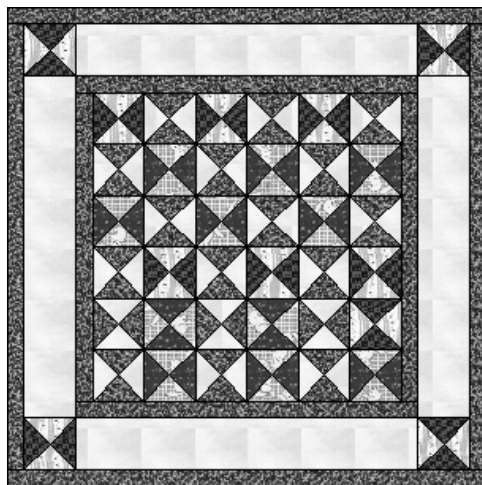
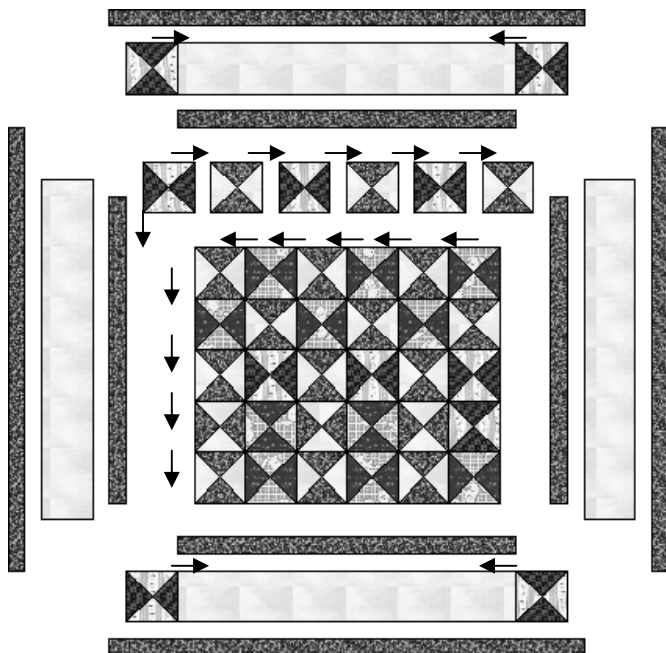


3. Place the pieces from step 2, right sides together. Draw a line from corner to corner, bisecting the seam line. Sew a 1/4" from both sides of the line. Cut exactly on the line and iron out. Repeat to make a total of 40 using the pairs. You will get 2 squares per pair of fabrics. Square to 4".



Make 40 - 2 per pair of fabric

4. Sew the together and iron rows in opposite directions.



5. Quilt, bind and enjoy!
